Hraunbyrgi, Scout Center Hafnarfjörður, Iceland



We are open from the beginning of May to the end of September, welcoming groups and individuals to Hafnarfjörður.

Our mission is to create an inspiring and engaging space for Scouting activities and outdoor adventures.

Hraunbyrgi is a Scout center located in Hafnarfjörður, a town known for its rich history and close connection to nature, elves and vikings. Owned and operated by the Scouting group Hraunbúar, the center offers excellent facilities, including camping grounds, hostel-style accommodations for up to 45 people, and a variety of activities both on-site and nearby.

During the winter season, we accommodate groups of 10 or more, providing a comfortable and convenient base for your activities.

Hraunbyrgi is easily accessible, located only 30 minutes from Keflavík International Airport and connected to Iceland's Ring Road. Hafnarfjörður is close to Reykjavík, and the capital's vibrant city center is just a short drive away, offering additional attractions and amenities.

As Hraunbúar approach their 100th anniversary in 2025, we are transitioning Hraunbyrgi from primarily serving as a tourist facility to becoming a dedicated Scout center.

We are a one hour drive from Reykjavík, and about 1,5 hour from the international airport (Keflavík). Plenty of Iceland's most visited tourist attractions are within a 1-2 hour drive from Úlfljótsvatn.

Hamrar, Scout Center Akureyri, Iceland



We are open all year around and welcome groups and individuals to the north.

Rented equipment available for groups. Direct flights from UK, Holland and Switzerland to Akureyri airport and only about 5 km from the airport to us. Akureyri is by Iceland's Ring road and it is about 5 hours drive from Reykjavik to the north.

Hamrar is a large campsite located just outside off Akureyri, we have good facilities, camping grounds and wide range off activities on or off site.

During winter we can offer groups access to our local scout huts for groups and the campsite is also with great opportunities for winter activities.
